under Permit No. 22987 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **May 10, 1954**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.05 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the Lot 1 (SE\frac{1}{2} SW\frac{1}{2}), Section 26, T. 24 S., R. 13 W.,

W. M. Diversion point located 160 feet South and 530 feet West from the NE

Corner, SE\(\frac{1}{2}\) Sw\(\frac{1}{2}\), Section 26.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to \(-----\) of one cubic foot per second per acre,
