## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

a tributary of Columbia River irrigation of 20.9 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. G-2163 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 5, 1962

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.26 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW1 NW1, as projected within Pullen DLC LLL, Section 29, T. 1 N., R. 3 E., W. M. Well located 1560 feet North and 2675 feet West from the SE Corner DLC LLL.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to the eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.6 acres NE W W A
3.0 acres NM NW A
13.8 acres SW NW A
2.5 acres SE W NW A
all as projected within Pullen DIC hh
Section 29
T. 1 N., R. 3 E., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
