under Permit No. G-2747 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 24, 1964

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.67 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 1 (NE4 SE4), Section 30, T. 1 N., R. 3 E., W. M. Well located 1400 feet North and 25 feet West from the SE Corner, Section 30.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to \_ \_ \_ \_ \_ \_ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

This right is subject to the provision that use of water for air conditioning in excess of 5000 gallons per day shall be subsequent in priority to future bene icial consumptive use unless a two well system is constructed and all water wasted from the system recharged to the same ground water reservoir from which it was withdrawn.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
