CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ELMER AND LEAH CLACK
4640 Kentuck Way, North Bend THERON AND KATHRINE NORTHROP
of 4880 Kentuck Way, North Bend, State of Oregon, has made proof
to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of
Kentuck Creek and unnamed tributary

a tributary of Coos Bay for the purpose of
irrigation of 7.0 acres and domestic use of one family

under Permit No. 21025 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
confirmed dates from August 16, 1951

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed
0.095 cubic foot per second; being 0.005 c.f.s. from unnamed creek for domestic
and 0.09 c.f.s. from Kentuck Creek for irrigation;

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.
The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 3, T. 25 S., R. 12 W.,
W. M. Diversion points located: Kentuck Creek - 120 feet South and 320 feet
West, 560 feet South and 1010 feet West; Unnamed tributary - 720 feet North and *

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other
right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second
per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited
to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated
during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall
conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is
appurtenant, is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
