CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ERNEST H. LOUVRING

of Route 5, Box 1269, Eugene, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of seven unnamed springs area

a tributary of Willow Creek for the purpose of irrigation of 8.0 acres and domestic use of two families

under Permit No. 29397 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 13, 1964

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.09 cubic foot per second; being 0.08 c.f.s. for irrigation and 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic use

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Bailey DLC 40, Section 5, T. 18 S., R. 4 W., W. M. Diversion point located North 31° 25' 50" East 806.4 feet from the SW Corner of the DLC 40.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right to use of water is limited to the period when the flow of the Long Tom River is more than 25 c.f.s. at USGS Gage No. 1700;

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Domestic & 4.4 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
as projected within Bailey DLC 40
Section 4

3.6 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
as projected within Bailey DLC 40
Section 5
T. 18 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
