CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That GENERAL FOODS CORPORATION BIRDS EYE DIVISION

of P. O. Box 36, Woodburn, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of G. F. Well No. 3 and G. F. Well No. 4

a tributary of Pudding River (Willamette River) for the purpose of industrial food processing

under Permit No. G-1968 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 11, 1961

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 2.89 cubic feet per second; being 1.11 c.f.s. from Well No. 3 and 1.78 c.f.s. from Well No. 4

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW 1/4 SW 1/4, as projected within Bonney DIC 47, Section 17, T. 5 S., R. 1 W., W. M. Wells located: 1560 feet North and 1510 feet West; 1100 feet North and 630 feet West; both from the SE Corner, Bonney DIC 47. The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4 NW 1/4 SW 1/4 both as projected within B. S. Bonney DIC 47 Section 17 T. 5 S., R. 1 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
