**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That**      **WENGER BROS.**

of **2205 105th Ave. NE, Salem**, State of **Oregon**, has made proof to the satisfaction of the **STATE ENGINEER** of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of **Beaver Creek and reservoir constructed under Application No. R-37260, Permit No. R-2709,**

a tributary of **Puttiding River** for the purpose of irrigation of **17.4 acres and supplemental irrigation of 15.2 acres**

under Permit No. **27759** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **December 15, 1961**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **0.41 cubic foot per second**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the **NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>**, as projected within **McAllister DIC 49, Section 17, T. 7 S., R. 1 W., W. M.** Diversion point located **720 feet East and 1630 feet North** from the **W<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> Corner, Section 17.**

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to **one-eightieth** of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow for lands described as primary and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed **2½ acre feet per acre** for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit No. **R-2709**; and further limited to the use of stored water only on lands described as supplemental;

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
