CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **AULDEN CHEEVER and RUTH CHEEVER**

of Box 17 A, Elkton, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Umpqua River

a tributary of Pacific Ocean for the purpose of irrigation of 7.0 acres

under Permit No. 29129 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 4, 1963 for 0.04 c.f.s.
December 11, 1963 for 0.03 c.f.s.

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.07 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Hathaway DIC 44, Section 21, T. 22 S., R. 8 W., W. M. Diversion point located 1570 feet North and 1710 feet East from the NW Corner, DIC 44.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right to use of water is limited to the period when the flow of the Umpqua River is more than 525 c.f.s. at tidewater;

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

6.2 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
0.8 acre NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
both as projected within Hathaway DIC 44
Section 21
T. 22 S., R. 8 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
