CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That EARL M. BROWN

of Route 2, Box 18, Jacksonville , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Sterling Creek and Hukill Hollow

a tributary of Little Applegate River irrigation of 7.9 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 26\(\text{l21}\) of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 2, 1959

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.10 cubic foot per second; being 0.04 c.f.s. from Sterling Creek and 0.06 c.f.s. from Hukill Hollow

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NN NA Notation 17, T. 39 S., R. 2 W., W. M. Diversion points located: Sterling Creek - 350 feet South and 880 feet East, Hukill Hollow - 550 feet South and 230 feet East; both from the NN Corner, *

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 12 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right to use of water is limited to the period when the flow of the Rogue River is 735 c.f.s. or more at its mouth.

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

* Section 17.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
