CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That FRY FARMS, INC.

of 606 High Street, SE, Salem, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Applegate River and Rogue River

a tributary of Pacific Ocean for the purpose of irrigation of 134.6 acres

under Permit No. 27402 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 11, 1961

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.68 cubic feet per second; being 0.42 c.f.s. from Applegate River and 1.26 c.f.s. from Rogue River

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 19, T. 36 S., R. 6 W., W. M. Diversion points located: Rogue - 4970 feet North and 530 feet East; Applegate - 1370 feet North and 4930 feet East; both from the SW Corner, Section 19. The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $4\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right to the use of water is limited to the period when the flow of the Rogue River is more than 735 c.f.s. at its mouth;

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
