## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

Certificate of water right issued to Theodore Jemison and recorded at page 7385, Volume 7, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms the right to the use of water for development of power, domestic, and irrigation of 30.0 acres. Subsequently, the right to the use of water appurtenant to 30.0 acres was canceled by order of the State Engineer entered March 23, 1967, and the right to the use of water for development of power expired August 8, 1962. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for domestic use and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to Theodore Jemison.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
