**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That** HARRY D. OGBORN

of 7990 Rogue River Highway, Grants Pass, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Rogue River

a tributary of \_\_\_\_\_ for the purpose of  
irrigation of 0.4 acre

under Permit No. 27649 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 6, 1961

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 1 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) Section 20, T. 36 S., R. 4 W., W. M. Diversion point located 30 feet West and 110 feet South from the SW Corner, Jewett DLG 40.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed  $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right to use of water is limited to the period when the flow of water in the Rogue River is more than 1000 c.f.s. immediately above Savage Rapids Dam and more than 735 c.f.s. at its mouth;

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.4 acre Lot 1 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ )  
Section 20  
T. 36 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
