CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That LANE MEMORIAL GARDENS

of 5300 11th Avenue West, Eugene, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Amazon Drainage Channel and reservoir constructed under Application No. R-39063, Permit No. R-3867 a tributary of Fern Ridge Reservoir for the purpose of supplemental irrigation of 22.4 acres

under Permit No. 29167 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 11, 1963

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.28 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 33, T. 17 S., R. 4 W., W. M. Diversion point located 780 feet East and 960 feet North from the W $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner, Section 33.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre; or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-3867; provided further that the right to use of direct flow is limited to the period when the flow of the Long Tom River is more than 25 c.f.s. at U.S.G.S. Gage No. 1700;

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

16.5 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
0.6 acre SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 32

5.3 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 33
T. 17 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
