CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **FRANK HUFF**

of Halfway, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Clear Creek and Pine Creek

a tributary of Snake River for the purpose of irrigation of 109.0 acres

under Permit No. 31152 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 20, 1965

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 2.60 cubic feet per second; being 1.42 c.f.s. from Clear Creek and 1.18 c.f.s. from Pine Creek

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 33, T. 7 S., R. 46 E., W. M. NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 4; NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 5, T. 8 S., R. 46 E., W. M.

Diversion points located below:
 The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Diversion points located: Clear Creek - 50 feet South and 930 feet West; Pine Creek - 120 feet North and 560 feet East, 670 feet South and 770 feet East; all from the NW Corner, Section 4.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
