**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That**      **MAXWELL L. THAYER**

of 26633 St. Andrews Drive, Sun City, State of California, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Middle Fork of Foots Creek

a tributary of Foots Creek for the purpose of irrigation of 5.0 acres

under Permit No. 27881 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 6, 1962

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.06 cubic foot per second.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 13, T. 37 S., R. 4 W., W. M. Diversion point located 30 feet West and 2200 feet North from the S $\frac{1}{4}$  Corner, Section 13.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed  $4\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right to use of water is limited to the period when the flow of the Rogus River is more than 1000 c.f.s. immediately above Savage Rapids Dam and more than 735 c.f.s. at its mouth;

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

5.0 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
 Section 13  
 T. 37 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
