This Is to Certify, That WM. B. and BOB L. WALCH

of B.F. Star Route, Box 141, Eagle Point, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to store the waters of Indian Creek and Dyer Creek, tributary of Rogue River, in Indian Lake Reservoir, appropriated under Application No. 26791, Permit No. 21925

for the purposes of irrigation

under Reservoir Permit No. R-1459 of the State Engineer, and that said right to store said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 18, 1952

that the amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right, for the purposes aforesaid, shall not exceed 1150.0 acre feet
