CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That CLIFFORD E. DOW and MILDRED L. DOW

of Jose Basin Road, Auberry, State of California, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Hog Creek

a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of domestic use of one family and commercial use in cafe

under Permit No. 28806 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 1, 1963

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.015 cubic foot per second; being 0.005 c.f.s. for domestic use and 0.01 c.f.s. for cafe use.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 1 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 11, T. 35 S., R. 7 W., W. M. Diversion point located 820 feet South and 930 feet East from the W $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner, Section 11.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Lot 1 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$)
Section 11
T. 35 S., R. 7 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
