CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That BOISE CASCADE CORPORATION

of P. O. Box 1458, Boise, State of Idaho, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of a well

a tributary of _____ for the purpose of industrial use in particle board plant and maintenance of fire protection system

under Permit No. G-2930 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 10, 1965 for 0.335 c.f.s. August 2, 1965 for 0.335 c.f.s.

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.67 cubic foot per second for industrial use and maintenance of fire protection system in an amount not to exceed 0.02 c.f.s.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 35, T. 2 S., R. 38 E., W. M. Well located 3260 feet North and 2989.4 feet West from the SE Corner, Section 35.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
