CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That GEORGE A. and MARY J. COLEMAN

of 2173 Fourth Street, Baker, State of Oregon, has a right
to the use of the waters of Powder River

a tributary of Snake River for the purpose of
irrigation of 20.0 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 6, at page 291; that the priority of the right thereby
confirmed dates from 1883

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one-fortieth of one
cubic foot per second per acre; and shall be subject to all other conditions and
limitations contained in said decree

This certificate is issued to correct and supersede certificate heretofore
issued to F. C. Vaughan and recorded in Volume 5, page 4531, State Record of
Water Right Certificates, so as to correctly describe the location of the lands
irrigated pursuant to Decree of the Circuit Court for Baker County entered
October 20, 1967.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described.
