CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That CLACKAMAS COUNTY

of Room 8, Courthouse, Oregon City, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of unnamed slough and reservoir constructed under Application No. R-39105, Permit No. R-3695 a tributary of Clackamas River for the purpose of recreation

under Permit No. 29068 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 26, 1963

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.2 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 23, T. 2 S., R. 3 E., W. M. Diversion point located 1410 feet East and 370 feet South from the W 1/4 Corner, Section 23.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4
Section 23
T. 2 S., R. 3 E., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
