29324 of the State Engineer, and that wid right to the use of said waters under Permit No. has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 18, 1964

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.285 cubic foot per second; being 0.28 c.f.s. for irrigation and 0.005 c.f.s. for domestic

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. W. M. Diversion points located: 1340 feet South and 800 feet East; 1640 feet South and 890 feet East; both from the Nr Corner, Section 5.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

> 6.4 acres Lot 9 ($NW_{1}^{1} NE_{1}^{1}$) Domestic and 16.2 acres Lot 8 (SW_4^1 NE_4^1) Section 5 T. 30 S., R. 12 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
