CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That GLEN D. EYMAN

of Box 65, Broadbent , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Dement Creek

a tributary of Coquille River irrigation of 12.3 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 27046 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 10, 1960

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.15 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW_{4}^{1} , NW_{4}^{1} , Section 25; NE_{4}^{1} , SE_{4}^{1} , NW_{4}^{1} , SE_{4}^{1}

Diversion points located below:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Diversion points located - 70 feet South and 2130 feet West; 340 feet South and 1750 feet West; 430 feet South and 1590 feet West; 430 feet South and 1200 feet West; 480 feet South and 660 feet West; 520 feet South and 290 feet West; 230 feet South and 130 feet West; 5 feet North and 270 feet East, 430 feet North and 730 feet East; 450 feet North and 880 feet East; all from the $E_{\rm h}^{\rm L}$ Corner, Section 26.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
