to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to store the waters of
Squaw Creek, tributary of Applegate River, in Dividend Bar Reservoir consisting
of five small ponds, appropriated under Application No. 34494, Permit No. 27085

for the purposes of

fish culture
under Reservoir Permit No. **R-2559** of the State Engineer, and that said right to store said
waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right
hereby confirmed dates from **December 5, 1960**

that the amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right, for the purposes afore-
said, shall not exceed **2.0 acre feet**
