## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

, has made proof of Route 1, Box 179-A, Eagle Point Oregon , State of to the satir action of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of unnamed gulch and Mayes Reservoir constructed under Application No. R-39681, Permit No. R-3965 a tributary of Antelope Creek for the purpose of

recreation

under Permit No. 29533 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 30, 1964

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.05 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW 1 SE 1, as projected within Tinkham DIC 50, Section 9, T. 36 S., R. 1 W., W. M. Diversion point located 550 feet West and 450 feet North from the SW Corner, Linkswiter DIC 49.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

> Swa Sea as projected within Tinkham DLC 50 Section 9 T. 36 S., R. 1 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
