CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That HAVEN T. BENSON

of Box 1, Joseph, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Spring Creek

a tributary of Wallowa River for the purpose of domestic use in one two-unit cabin, one three unit cabin, and one single unit cabin, including irrigation of not to exceed $\frac{1}{2}$ acre lawn and garden under Permit 24821 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been accepted in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 16, 1957

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 28, T. 3 S., R. 45 E., W. M. Diversion point located 860 feet South and 350 feet East from the NW Corner, Section 28.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
