## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That**          OREGON STATE FISH COMMISSION

of 307 State Office Building, Portland, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Lostine River

a tributary of          Wallowa River          for the purpose of  
operation of a fishway

under Permit No. 31060 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 3, 1965

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 10.0 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 27, T. 1 S., R. 43 E., W. M. Diversion point located South 64° 20' 35" West 3116.45 feet from the NE Corner, Section 27.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$   
SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 27  
T. 1 S., R. 43 E., W. M.

The right to use of water as allowed herein shall be subordinate and inferior to all future appropriations on Lostine River and its tributaries for all beneficial consumptive purposes.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
