CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** PAUL & KATHRYN WILEY, H. B. GILPATRICK,  
CHARLES H. HOFFMAN, MRS. F. C. HOFFMAN,  
M. M. LABART, and R. M. WARNER,

of Broadbent, State of Oregon, has made proof  
to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of  
springs A and B

a tributary of South Fork Coquille River for the purpose of  
domestic use of 9 families and stock

under Permit No. 29707 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters  
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby  
confirmed dates from June 2, 1964

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes  
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed  
0.02 cubic foot per second; being 0.015 c.f.s. for domestic use and 0.005 c.f.s.  
for stock

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.  
The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 33, SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 34, T. 29 S.,  
R. 12 W., W. M. Springs located: 420 feet North and 280 feet West; 200 feet  
North and 180 feet East; both from the E $\frac{1}{4}$  Corner, Section 33.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other  
right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second  
per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is  
appurtenant, is as follows:

Stock NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$   
Stock NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$   
Domestic SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$   
Domestic SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 28  
T. 29 S., R. 12 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of  
use herein described.
