CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That B. F. BANKS

of Williams, State of Oregon, has a right
to the use of the waters of Powell Creek

a tributary of Williams Creek for the purpose of
irrigation of 59.0 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the right thereby
confirmed dates from 1860

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.74 cubic foot per
second.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:

31.25 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
27.75 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$

Certificate of water right issued to B. F. Banks and recorded at page 16336,
Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms the right to the
use of water for irrigation of 105.49 acres. Subsequently, the right to the
use of water appurtenant to 46.49 acres was transferred by order of the State
Engineer entered January 3, 1968. This certificate is issued to confirm the
remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate
heretofore issued to B. F. Banks.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described.
