Troutdale . State of , has made proof Oregon to the satisfaction of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Spring on O.W.R & N. Co.right of way, near Sandy River, near Troutdale, Oregon, for the purpose of irrigation and domestic under Permit No. 4711 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon and duly confirmed by order of the STATE WATER BOARD of G. gon, made and entered of record in the Record of Proceedings of 17th day of October. 1921; said Board, at Salem, in Volume 1 , at page 410 , on the that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 26. 1920

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.24 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The use hereunder for irrigation shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the lands under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: 11.91 acres in the Southwest quarter of Northwest quarter and 7.04 acres in the Southeast quarter of Northwest quarter of Section Twenty-five, Township One North, Range Three East of Willamette Meridian, in Multnomah County, Oregon. (Being a total of 18.95 acres)

: The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

Rights to the use of water for power purposes are limited to a period of forty years from the date of priority of the right, as herein set forth, subject to a preference right of renewal under the laws existing at the date of the expiration of the right for power purposes, as hereby confirmed and limited.
