CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That SPRINGFIELD SAND & GRAVEL COMPANY

of P. O. Box 16, Springfield, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Middle Fork Willamette River

a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of manufacturing (washing gravel)

under Permit No. 29218 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 16, 1963

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.89 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW¹/₄ NW¹/₄, as projected within Magueas DLC 50, Section 8, T. 18 S., R. 2 W., W. M. Diversion point located 1150 feet South and 400 feet West from the SW Corner, Arthur DLC 63.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

The right to use of water is limited to the period when the flow of the Middle Fork Willamette River is more than 1025 c.f.s. at its mouth, and is subject to maintenance and use of adequate treatment facilities to remove the sediment before returning the water to the stream.

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Lot 8 (SE¹/₄ NE¹/₄)
Section 1
T. 18 S., R. 3 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
