CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That WALLACE JACOBSEN

of Route 1, Box 227, Silverton State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Silver Creek and an unnamed spring

a tributary of Pudding River for the purpose of domestic use of one family and irrigation of 6.0 acres

under Permit No. 28914 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 30, 1963

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.085 cubic foot per second; being 3.08 c.f.s. for irrigation from creek, and 0.005 c.f.s. for domestic from spring

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ as projected within Smith DLC 54; Lot 2 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 2, T. 7 S., R. 1 W., W. M.

Diversion points located below:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Domestic and 1.2 acres Lot 2 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$)
2.8 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ as projected within Smith DLC 54
0.4 acre SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ as projected within Barger DLC
1.6 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ as projected within Smith DLC 54
Section 2
T. 7 S., R. 1 W., W. M.

Diversion points located: Creek - 2225 feet West and 380 feet North; Spring - 2470 feet West and 5 feet North; both from the E $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner, Section 2.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
