CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

, has made proof of Ibaraki Ken, to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of a well

a tributary of Pudding River (Willamette River) irrigation of 35.3 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 6-2589 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 28, 1963

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.21 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NWL SWL, as projected within Palanquin DLC 42, Section 22, T. 5 S., R. 2 W., W. M. Well located 2120 feet due West from NE Corner. Palancuin DIC 42.
The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second peracre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 22 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

> O.1 acre NEL SE 0.3 acre SEL SEL both as projected within Palanquin DLC 42

> > Section 21

2.0 acres NEL SW 20.4 acres NWL SW 11.7 acres SW SW 0.8 acre SEL SWL all as projected within Palanquin DLC 42 Section 22 T. 5 S., R. 2 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
