CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

A. J. ROTH AND FERN L. ROTH

of Route 2, La Grande , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Springs Nos. 1, 2, and 4, and Hot Lake Reservoir constructed under Application No. R-37102, Permit No. R-2713 a tributory of Catherine Creek for the purpose of irrigation of 145.3 acres, fish culture, group domestic, heating, baths, swimming and therapy pools under Permit No. 27696 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 9, 1961

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 4.36 cubic feet per second; being 0.27 c.f.s. from spring No. 1; 0.58 c.f.s. from spring No. 2; 2.78 c.f.s. from spring No. 4 for irrigation; 0.20 c.f.s. from spring No. 1 and reservoir for fish culture; 0.14 c.f.s. from spring No. 2 for group* or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the Lot 4 (NW SW), Lot 6 (NW SE), Section 5, T. 4 S., R. 39 E., W. M. Diversion points located: Spring No. 1 - 360 feet South and 40 feet East; Spring No. 2 - 420 feet South and 120 feet East; Spring No. 4 - **

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right to all uses except domestic shall be limited to the period when the flow of the Grande Ronde River is more than 300 c.f.s. at U.S.G.S. Gage No. 3325 and more than 420 c.f.s. at U.S.G.S. Gage No. 3330;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
