CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **NORMAN BUTLER**

of Route 1, Baker, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of 4 unnamed drainageways and 3 seepage collection ditches

a tributary of Pine Creek (Powder River) for the purpose of irrigation of 115.0 acres and supplemental irrigation of 83.5 acres

under Permit No. 29016 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 28, 1962

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 2.50 cubic feet per second; being 0.25 c.f.s. from unnamed drainageway A, 0.125 c.f.s. from unnamed drainageway B, 0.125 c.f.s. from unnamed drainageway C, 0.50 c.f.s. from unnamed drainageway D, and 0.50 c.f.s. from each of the 3 seepage* or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the SW¹/₄ SE¹/₄, Section 28, NW¹/₄ NE¹/₄, SW¹/₄ NE¹/₄, Section 33, T. 8 S., R. 39 E., W. M. Diversion point located below:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Diversion points located: unnamed drainageways, 1320 feet North and 5 feet East; 350 feet North and 5 feet East; 540 feet South and 5 feet East; 1440 feet South and 5 feet East; Collection ditches between points: 1320 feet North and 5 feet East and 350 feet North and 5 feet East; 540 feet South and 5 feet East and 1450 feet South and 5 feet East; 1980 feet South and 5 feet East and 2635 feet South and 1160 feet East; all from the N¹/₄ Corner, Section 33.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
