a tributary of Umpqua River irrigation of 20.7 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 30568 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 17, 1965

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.26 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 12(NEL SWL), Lot 11 (NWL SEL), Section 10, T. 22 S., R. 8 W., W. M. Diversion points located 2640 feet West and 290 feet South, 3220 feet West and 1150 feet South; both from the RL Corner Section 10 ther right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

2.1 acres Lot 12 (NE¹/₁ SW¹/₂) 0.5 acre Lot 13 (NW¹/₂ SW¹/₂) 0.8 acre Lot 15 (SE¹/₂ SW¹/₂) 8.8 acres Lot 10 (NE¹/₂ SE¹/₂) 8.5 acres Lot 11 (NW¹/₂ SE¹/₂) Section 10 T. 22 S., R. 8 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the warer for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
