CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **PETER HANSEN**

of **Route 1, Box 105, Springfield** , State of **Oregon** , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of **Mohawk River**

a tributary of **McKenzie River**
irrigation of **77.0 acres**

for the purpose of

under Permit No. **27770** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **December 26, 1961**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **0.96 cubic foot per second**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the **Lot 1 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$) and NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ as projected within Stafford DLC 78, Section 9, Township 17 South, Range 2 West, W.M. Div. Pts. located below: ***

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to **one-eightieth** of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed **2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right to use of water is limited to the period when the flow of the Mohawk River is more than 20 cubic foot per second at its mouth, and the flow of the McKenzie River is more than 1025 cubic foot per second at Hiway No. 99,**

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
