under Permit No. 31393 of the State Engineer, and that sailing ht to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby June 27, 1966 confirmed dates from

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.015 cubic foot per second; being 0.005 c.f.s. for domestic and 0.01 c.f.s. for irrigation

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 3 (NWL SWL), Section 24, T. 3 N., R. 2 W., W. M. Spring located 340 feet North and 300 feet West from SW Corner, Jackson DLC 44.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

> Domestic and 0.5 acre Lot 3 (NW SW) Section 24 T. 3 N., R. 2 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
