CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ESTATE OF RUBY W. DUNN
c/o Kenneth W. Dunn
of 4246 River Road, Junction City, State of Oregon, has made proof
to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of
Well No. 3

a tributary of Willamette River (Columbia River) for the purpose of
irrigation of 56.0 acres

under Permit No. G-2000 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
confirmed dates from November 28, 1961

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed
0.70 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.
The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Hulings DLC 49,
Section 16, T. 16 S., R. 4 W., W. M. Well located 820 feet North and 1000
feet East from SW Corner, DLC 49.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other
right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second
per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is
appurtenant, is as follows:

- 14.2 acres Lot 2 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$)
- 18.0 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ as projected within Hulings DLC 49
Section 16
- 23.8 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ as projected within Hulings DLC 49
Section 21
T. 16 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
