a tributary of Fanno Creek irrigation of 121.6 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. G-2272 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 26, 1962

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.52 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NWL NEL; SEL NWL, Section 26, T. 1 S., R. 1 W., W. M. Wells located 730 feet South and 280 feet East; 2030 feet South and 210 feet West; both from NL Corner, Section 26.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation s. Ion of each year;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

8.8 acres SW1 SE1 Section 23

32.4 acres NWt NEt 26.6 acres SWt NEt 25.4 acres NEt NWt 27.6 acres SEt NWt 0.8 acre NWt SEt Section 26

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
