CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That GRACE AITKEN
of Sisters, State of Oregon has a right to the use of
the waters of Squaw Creek, a tributary of Deschutes River
for the purpose of irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
CROOK County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 1, at page 433; ;
that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1886

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one-fiftieth of one
cubic foot per second per acre.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:
Lots 1 and 12 of Block 7 Davidson's Addition to the Town of Sisters, Oregon.
(containing approximately 0.25 acre and being in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 9, Township
15 S. R. 10 E. W. M.)

(NOTE: This certificate is issued to correct that certain certificate issued
June 1, 1914, to F. W. McCaffery, Rachael McCaffery and John W. Dennis, and
recorded in State Record of Water Right Certificates, Vol. 1, Page 448, the
purpose being to transfer the water right appurtenant under said former cer-
tificate to Lots 11 and 12 of Block 6, original townsite of Sisters, Oregon,
to the above described tract)

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described.
