CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is To Certify, That

JOHN C. MCKENZIE

of Route 2, Box 131, Estacada , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Clear Creek, unnamed stream and reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-626 a tributary of Clackamas River for the purpose of primary irrigation of 65.4 acres and supplemental irrigation of 20.0 acres under Permit No. 20682 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 23, 1950

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.065 cubic feet per second; being 1.055 c.f.s. from Clear Creek and 0.01 c.f.s. from unnamed stream and reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-626.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW_{h}^{1} , SW_{h}^{1} , as projected within Norton DLC 46, Section 11; SW_{h}^{1} , SE_{h}^{1} , as projected within R. Mattoon DLC 47, Section 10, T. 3 S., R. 3 E., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-626;

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Certificate of water right issued to John C. McKenzie and recorded at page 26416, Volume 18, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms the right to the use of water for irrigation of 90.6 acres. Subsequently, the point of diversion for the irrigation of 5.2 acres was transferred by order of the State Engineer entered February 16, 1968. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to John C. McKenzie.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
