CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

JAMES WILLIAM REYNOLDS

of Jacksonville , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Glade Creek, Little Applegate River

a tributary of Applegate River irrigation of 19.0 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 3637 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 17, 1917

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.24 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Certificate of water right issued to James William Reynolds and recorded at page 4800 Volume 5, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms the right to the use of water for irrigation of 65.0 acres. Subsequently, the right to the use of water appurtenant to 46.0 acres was transferred by order of the State Engineer entered March 18, 1968. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to James William Reynolds.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
