**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That**      ROY W. SAXTON

of Route 1, Box 170, Scappoose, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Saxton Well

a tributary of Jackson Creek (Multnomah Channel) for the purpose of irrigation of 2.9 acres and domestic use in a 52 space trailer court, store, and 7 houses under Permit No. G-521 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 4, 1957

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.24 cubic foot per second; being 0.04 c.f.s. for irrigation and 0.20 c.f.s. for domestic

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within Jackson DLC 44, Section 24, T. 3 N., R. 2 W., W. M. Well located 70 feet South and 3010 feet East from the W $\frac{1}{2}$  Corner of Section 24. The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eighth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.  
A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Domestic and 0.9 acre SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$   
Domestic and 0.7 acre SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$   
Domestic and 0.3 acre NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
Domestic and 1.0 acre NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$   
all as projected within Jackson DLC 44  
Section 24  
T. 3 N., R. 2 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
