**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That** LLOYD C. and THELMA S. LEONARD

of Box 154, Umpqua, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Hubbard Creek and Day Creek

a tributary of Umpqua River for the purpose of irrigation of 2.3 acres and domestic use of one family

under Permit No. 28736 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 2, 1963

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.04 cubic foot per second; being 0.03 c.f.s. for irrigation from Hubbard Creek and 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic from Day Creek.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 36, T. 25 S., R. 8 W., W. M. Diversion points located South 3° 18' West 3852.7 feet; South 11° 52' West 3261.0 feet; both from the NE Corner of Section 36.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right to use of water is limited to the period when the flow of the Umpqua River is more than 525 c.f.s. at tidewater;

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Domestic and 2.3 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 36  
T. 25 S., R., 8 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
