CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

of Box 455, Roseburg , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of North Umpqua River

a tributary of Umpqua River irrigation of 1.0 acre

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 31323 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 9, 1966

that the mount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesa's, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01, cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NET NWT, as projected within Akin DLC 51, Section 30, T. 26 3., R. 5 W., W. M. Diversion point located 2327.47 feet North and 2102.5 feet East from WT Corner, Section 30.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightlieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.0 acre NE¹/₄ NW¹/₄ as projected within Akin DLC 51 Section 30 T. 26 S., R. 5 W., W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is more explicitly described as follows: Lot 2 Rio Verde Tracts.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
