CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That MRS. DORIS A. BOYD

of Route 1, Box 960, Cave Junction, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of East Fork Illinois River

a tributary of _____ for the purpose of irrigation of 0.9 acre and domestic use of one family

under Permit No. 29338 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 14, 1963

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.015 cubic foot per second; being 0.010 c.f.s. for irrigation and 0.005 c.f.s. for domestic

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 21, T. 39 S., R. 8 W., W. M. Diversion point located 710 feet North and 560 feet West from the SE Corner, SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 21.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fiftieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $\frac{3}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right to use of water is limited to the period when the flow of the Illinois River is more than 80 c.f.s. at its mouth and the flow of the Rogue River is more than 735 c.f.s. at its mouth;

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Domestic and 0.9 acre SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 21
T. 39 S., R. 8 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
