CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

of 4941 Granite Hill Road, Grants Pass , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Unnamed Creek

a tributary of Dunlap Creek

for the purpose of

irrigation of 0.4 acre and domestic use of one family

under Permit No. 29566 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 17, 1964

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.015 cubic foot per second; being 0.01 c.f.s. for irrigation and 0.005 c.f.s for domestic

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NET SET, Section 28, T. 35 S., R. 5 W., W. M. Diversion point located 330 feet South and 1270 feet West from Et Corner,

Section 28.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one—eightleth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.4 acre and Domestic SEL NEL Section 28 T. 35 S., R. 5 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
