## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

## This Is to Certify, That

JOSEPH HARRISON and WILMA HARRISON

of Route 2, Box 99, La Grande , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of McAllister Slough

a tributary of Grande Ronde River irrigation of 143.0 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 30077 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 1, 1964

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount ac ally beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 2.0 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the  $SW_L^2$   $SE_L^2$ , Section 1, T. 3 S., R. 38 E., W. M. Diversion point located 1550 feet South and 1450 feet West from the  $E_u^1$  Corner, Section 1.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

30.1 acres NEL SEL 35.7 acres NWL SEL 38.9 acres SWL SEL 38.0 acres SEL SEL Section 1 T. 3 S., R. 38 E., W. M.

0.3 acre NWA SWA Section 6
T. 3 S., R. 39 E., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
