**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That** MELVIN FINEGAN

of Route 2, Box 54, Cornelius, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Dairy Creek

a tributary of Tualatin River for the purpose of irrigation of 19.2 acres

under Permit No. 18299 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 4, 1948

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.214 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within Wren DLC 54, Section 21, T. 1 N., R. 3 W., W. M. Diversion point located 500 feet South and 1220 feet East from the most Northerly NE Corner, Beal DLC 64.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

11.0 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$   
8.2 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$   
both as projected within Beal DLC 64  
Section 28  
T. 1 N., R. 3 W., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use approved by orders of the State Engineer entered March 18, 1968, and April 25, 1968, and supersedes certificate of water right heretofore issued to Anna Reh and recorded at page 20035, Volume 14, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
