CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is To Certify, That ESTATE OF MRS. ANNIE FRANCIS
c/o Jess F. Francis
of 2357 Madison, Klamath Falls, State of Oregon, has made proof
to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of
Jackson Creek and an unnamed creek
a tributary of Williamson River for the purpose of
irrigation of 889.4 acres
under Permit No. 28171 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
confirmed dates from April 24, 1962

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed
22.24 cubic feet per second; being 20.02 c.f.s. from Jackson Creek and 2.22 c.f.s.
from unnamed creek

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.
The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$, NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 18, T. 30 S., R. 11 E., W. M.
Diversion points located 5 feet South and 640 feet West; 40 feet South and 320
feet West; 5 feet South and 110 feet West; all from NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner, Section 18.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other
right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second
per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to
a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during
the irrigation season of each year, and the right allowed herein shall be subject
to prior existing rights of the Klamath Project of the Bureau of Reclamation,
U. S. Department of the Interior, and appropriation of water as authorized herein
shall be subject to the construction and maintenance of a suitable outlet in any
diversion dam operated in connection with this appropriation to allow the free
passage of the natural flow of the stream; and shall
conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is
appurtenant, is as follows:
